



## 2018-2019 F.C. Portland Senior Competitive Program (U15-U18/19)

The F.C. Portland U15-U18/19 Senior Competitive Program is for players that are interested in playing at the highest level of club soccer. Players are required to tryout at the beginning of each year and selected players will be placed into our pool system for each age. The Senior Competitive Program will focus on all components of the game: technical, tactical, psychological, & physical. The training sessions are geared towards maximizing the player’s growth & total development of every player with the understanding that this focus will result in successful teams. The goal of the program is to challenge, improve, and advance the level of every player and prepare them for the future on and off the field.

### Competitive Program U15-U18/19 Cost –

#### Cost Includes

- Player training fees from May 2018-April 2019.
- Player, coach and team registration with governing association.
- Winter league entry fee.
- State Cup/President’s Cup entry fee.
- Coach’s compensation throughout the season.
- Use of fields & equipment.
- Administrative services from a professional staff.

#### Cost Does NOT Include

- Required uniforms and training gear.
- **Team Account Player Fees that will include and not be limited to:** Optional Tournament/Showcase Entry Fees; Team, coach, and manager travel cost to games/events, Travel (flights/gas, food, hotel, rental cars, coach and manager cost, etc.).

Uniforms—All new players are required to wear the proper training gear to practice and the proper uniforms to games. This equipment can be purchased at The Far Post. Address: 825 SW 14th Ave, Portland, OR 97205, Phone Number: (503) 295-6875. Training gear and uniforms will be available starting in June, 2018. Backpack orders can be placed starting the same day.

Training—Teams will train two/three nights per week, with each team having different schedules that will be announced after tryouts.

League— All of our senior teams will participate in a Winter league with games on Saturdays and Sundays starting in January.

Financial Assistance—Financial Assistance is available to families who qualify. The Financial Assistance application can be found on our website and must be turned in along with the requested documentation within **the deadline of July 31<sup>st</sup> 2018 in order to be considered.**

Payment Plans—Families that do not pay in full can opt to pay their fee on a payment plan. Once a player accepts their position on the team, they will need to submit their deposit or pay in full. If you are interested in having a payment plan this option can be selected once logged into your bonzi account and clicking “pay now”
