ECNL Cost –

Club Dues Include

- Player training fees from May 2019-June 2020
- Player, coach and team registration with ECNL
- ECNL league/referee fees
- Coaches' compensation throughout the season
- Coaches travel costs (flights and hotels)
- Use of fields & equipment
- Administrative services from a professional staff

Club Dues DO NOT Include

- Required uniforms and training gear
- **Team Account Player Fees that will include and not be limited to:** Tournament/Showcase Entry Fees; Team, and manager travel cost to games/events; Travel (flights/gas, food, hotel, rental cars, coach and manager cost, etc.). Team travel account dues are expected to be paid promptly to the team's treasures. Dates for team account payments are listed on the FC Portland ECNL paperwork.

Uniforms—All new players are required to wear the proper training gear to practice and the proper uniforms to games. This equipment can be purchased at The Far Post. Address: 825 SW 14th Ave, Portland, OR 97205, Phone Number: (503) 295-6875.

Training gear and uniforms will be available starting mid-June, 2019. Backpack orders can be placed starting the same day. ECNL players should also request the official "ECNL Logo" to be printed on the jersey.

Training—Teams will train three to four nights per week.

Financial Assistance—Financial assistance is available to families who qualify. Players that need financial assistance, must state that on their tryout form. The financial assistance application can be found on our website under, Information > Forms and must be turned in along with the requested documentation **within the deadline of July 31st 2019 in order to be considered.**

Payment Plans—Once a player accepts their position on the team, they will need to submit their deposit or pay in full. If you are interested in having a payment plan this option can be selected once logged into your Stack Sports account and clicking "pay now"
